A meeting was held on June 14, 2014 at 11am at the Buck's Restaurant, Williamstown. Thanks to all those who attended!!!


We had a member of the DEC join Steve and others on a ride June 7th through about 32 miles of our trail system. This member is in charge of all the state land outside of the Adirondack park. He was taken on some of our good trails, rougher trails, places where there was water and mud and showed him some of the work we do on our trails. He was very impressed with what we do to maintain our trails and the areas around them, as well as not damaging any wildlife areas. He knows a mud hole is a mud hole and not something that we damage by riding or working on the trails. This should hopefully help in getting some trails on state land.

This area of the trail will soon, if not already, have a posted speed limit of 10mph. We ask that you adhere to this. Thank you for your cooperation!
