If at 4:30 there have been NO "plops", the winners will be determined by a drawing, if there has been only 1 "plop" by 4:30, the remaining prizes will be determined by a drawing.

There will be 2 judges and any dispute or claims must be registered with said judges and their determination(s) will be the final say.
