A note from our Secretary Leslie:

Do you ever wonder why some people hold up numbers or a fist when they pass you on the trail? It is a way to communicate how many people are in your group. For example, there are 5 people in your group and you meet a group of 3 coming from the other direction. The first person in your group would hold up 4 fingers, meaning there are 4 people after them. The next person in the group would hold up 3 fingers, and so on until the last person in the group hold up a fist or a 0, meaning they are the last person in the group. The first person in the other group would hold up a 2, the next a 1, and the last a fist or 0. That way everyone in each group knows how many people to watch for. If there is a single rider, they would hold up a fist or 0, so the other person will know there are no others behind them. And so on. If there are any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

Also, follow hand signals for turning, stopping, slowing, etc. It lets others know what you are doing.

Always ride with your lights on! This makes it easier for everyone, motorists included, to see you.

Please ride safely!!!


