Meeting Highlights & Other News:

- *August's meeting was held at the Clubhouse there were 60+ in attendance. We have had a great turn out to all of the meetings so far this year! Thank you to all those who have attended!!
- *The club is raffling a four wheeler this year, tickets are \$5 each, contact Mike to buy or sell. Drawing will be August 10th at the landowner/worker dinner, held at the clubhouse this year.
- *Landowner/Worker Dinner is being held on August 10th this year, this is to allow more of our landowners to attend the dinner. It will be held at the clubhouse this year. Free to our landowners, their families and our workers. Steak & chicken dinners will be available for purchase as well. Price to be determined.
- *When sending in your membership application or applying on line, please allow some time for processing. You will not get your membership card and stickers the next day. There are over 100 or more at any given time to process. Each one has to be looked over to make sure all information is correct and proper fee has been paid. If it has been longer than a couple weeks since you applied and haven't gotten anything, then contact Becky. She works a full time job and has a family. If you apply online, save a copy of your receipt and carry it with you when you ride until you get your card and stickers. Same if you apply at the campground through Mike. You will get a receipt, this can be used to ride. If you have any questions, contact Becky.
- *There was a mistake in the time listed for the landowner/worker dinner. The correct time is 12pm-3pm, August 10th at the clubhouse pavilion, NOT 1-4pm, sorry for any inconvenience this may have caused anyone.
- *Altar Union Station has been having some issues with people parking/riding in their driveway. Use slow speeds when driving through the parking lot, either in your vehicle to unload or on your machine, they have customers going in and out of there and some have complained about the dust and throwing stones as riders are going past cars. SLOW DOWN! There is no need to ride fast through there. Also, no spinning of tires, peeling out, skidding, etc on the grass. If caught you will be responsible to fix it. This is a club sponsor and they have allowed members to park and unload there, if this continues, they will not be letting anyone park or unload there. STOP! It's getting out of hand.
- *It was suggested last year that the campground and pavilion should dedicated in memory of Bert. During the meeting, a placque with Bert's picture and one dedicating the camprground and pavilion in memory of him were presented by Steve, Jim, Mary, Bert's grandchildren and several other family members. An extended moment of silence was held after the dedication. If applications are not complete, they will be returned to you in the mail.


- *Williamstown Trail: there is a plan to get a trail into Williamstown, this is being worked on, watch for updates

- *Trail speed limits have been set to 25mph or less on ALL trails.
- *Please be careful when out riding, slow down for curves, hills, blind spots, hazards, etc., be sure your lights are on for better visability. Also, some of our safety course kids/adults are out on the trails trying to get used to their machines, trails, etc.
- *If there is a trail marked closed and it has ribbon, signs, gates or any other such things, then the trail is closed. <u>Do Not</u> go around. It may be closed do to a hazard, issue with a landowner, hunting (if there is at the time) or many other things. We have trails that open and close at different times throughout the riding season. 


