Each ticket is \$50. This can be paid all at once or in 5 payments of \$10 each April through August. If the entire cost of the ticket is paid in full by June 15th the holder of the ticket will be eligible for a special drawing of \$100. to be held at the *regular monthly meeting* in Williamstown at the Fireman's Field on June 16th. The winner of this special drawing is also eligible for the final drawings.
