IMPORTANT TRAIL INFO

The trails are now open but some trails are presently closed. Please be aware of this information before you start riding.

The Nevermore Trail to Gantley Trail and Bertha Mae Trail leading to Route 104 are closed. The Play Pen area is in this area and is affected by this closure. A new landowner has been contacted to give permission to ride these trails, but no firm answer has been received. Until such time as we receive permission **do not ride this trail.**

The Yamaha Trail is temporarily closed due to logging that is ongoing. We will let you know when it is open for the season.

The Dam Rd. Trail is closed for the month of May to allow the landowner to turkey hunt.
